- 5. Turn the canvas and YO again. Insert the needle into the first hole on row 2 and pull the yarn through. YO again and insert the needle into the next hole on row 2, creating a second loop. YO again and insert the needle into the third hole on row 2, creating a third loop.
- 6. YO and draw the yarn through all three loops on the needle to create a SC. Repeat this process until you reach the end of row 2.
- 7. Continue crocheting in rows until you reach the top of the canvas, or desired height of the vase.

Step 2: Create the Vase Opening

1. For the first row of the opening, skip the first three holes on the top row of the canvas.

- 2. YO and insert the needle into the fourth hole on the top row. Pull the yarn through to create a loop. YO again and insert the needle into the next hole on the top row, creating a second loop. YO again and insert the needle into the third hole on the top row, creating a third loop.
- 3. YO and draw the yarn through all three loops on the needle to create a SC. Repeat this process until you reach the end of the row.
- 4. For the second row of the opening, skip the first two holes on the top row of the canvas.
- 5. YO and insert the needle into the third hole on the top row. Pull the yarn through to create a loop. YO again and insert the needle into the next hole on the top row, creating a second loop. YO again and insert the needle into the fifth hole on the top row, creating a third loop.
- 6. YO and draw the yarn through all three loops on the needle to create a SC. Repeat this process until you reach the end of the row.
- 7. Continue decreasing the number of holes skipped for each row until you reach the desired opening size.

Step 3: Add Trim and Embellishments

- 1. Once the vase is completed, you can add trim or embellishments to give it a festive touch. For example, you can crochet a simple border around the top edge of the vase, or add a ribbon or lace trim.
- 2. You can also glue on sequins, beads, or other embellishments to create a one-of-a-kind design.




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
