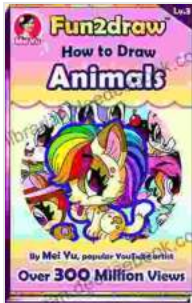

6. Add four legs to the body by drawing four lines from the chest and belly.
7. Draw a tail by adding a long, curved line to the back of the body.
8. Erase any unnecessary lines and add some details, such as whiskers and claws.

Tiger

1. Start by drawing a circle for the head. Add two ovals for the eyes and a triangle for the nose.
2. Draw a curved line for the mouth and add some lines for the teeth.
3. Draw two large triangles for the ears.
4. Draw a series of stripes on the tiger's face and body.

5. Draw the body of the tiger by adding a large oval for the chest and a smaller oval for the belly.

Elephant

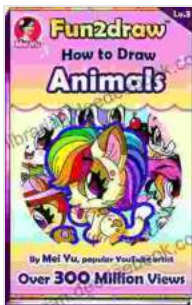
1. Start by drawing a large oval for the head.

Giraffe

1. Start by drawing a small oval for the head. Add two ovals for the eyes and a small oval for the nose.
2. Draw a long, curved line for the neck.

3. Draw a large oval for the body.
4. Add four legs to the body by drawing four lines from the body.
5. Draw a long, curved line for the tail.
6. Erase any unnecessary lines and add some details, such as spots and eyelashes.
