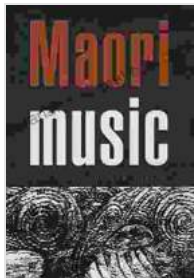

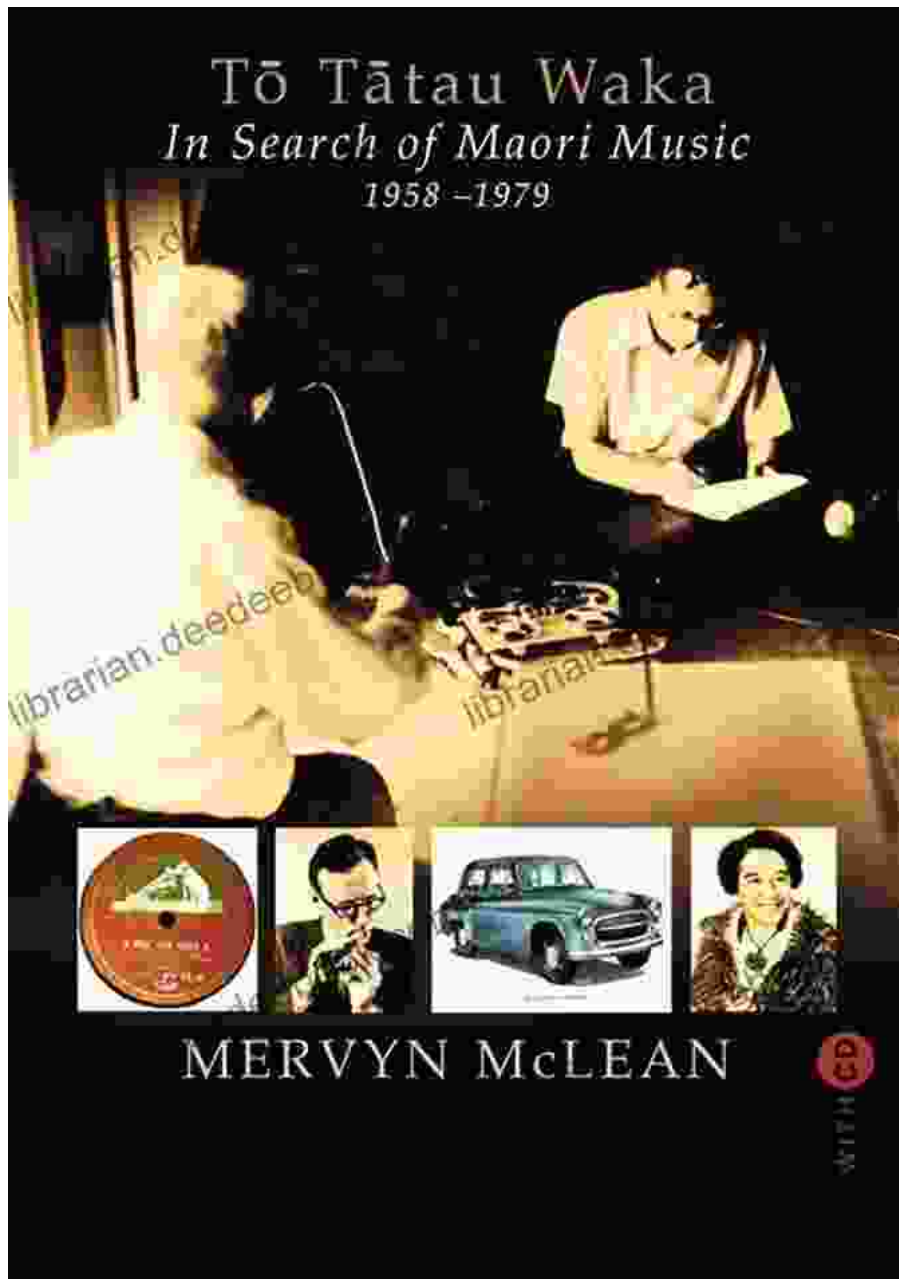

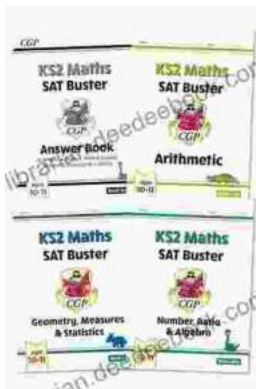

Maori Music by Mervyn McLean

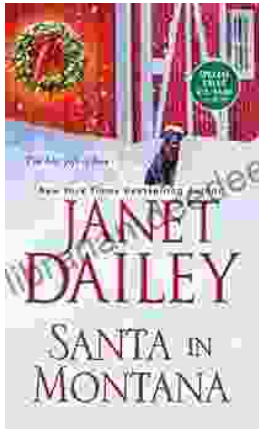
