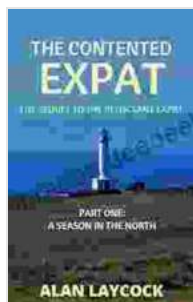


The Sequel to The Reluctant Expat: Part One

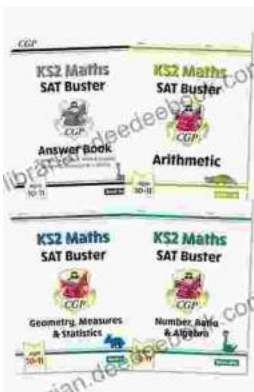

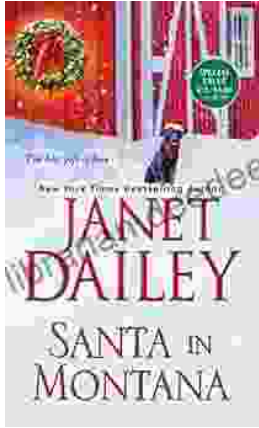
